All Classes 2021-2022



Young Dancers (Pre-Ballet & Tap, Pre-Tumbling)

Ballet & Tap:

Girls: Leotard and tights, or basic dance dress of any color. Dance skirts/shorts may also be worn. Pink, full sole ballet shoes. Black tap shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black full sole ballet shoes. Black tap shoes.

Tumbling:

Girls: Leotard and tights, basic dance dress or tumbling unitard of any color. Dance shorts may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Beginning Dancers

Ballet & Tap:

Girls: Pink short sleeve leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, full sole ballet shoes. Black tap shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black full sole ballet shoes. Black tap shoes.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored leotard*, footless tights. Dance shorts may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing in the studio colors. Sneakers (not chunky), dance sneakers or jazz shoes.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

Level 1

Ballet:

Girls: Mulberry leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, full sole ballet shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black full sole ballet shoes.

Tap: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn. Black leather lace up tap shoes.

Jazz: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn.

Girls: Nude split sole jazz shoes.

Boys: Black split sole jazz shoes.

Company: Ballet dress code with pink seamed tights for girls.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, footless or convertible tights. Dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing in Neutral or Academy colors*. Sneakers (not chunky), dance sneakers or jazz shoes.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

Level 2

Ballet:

Girls: Eggplant leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, split sole ballet shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black, split sole ballet shoes.

Tap: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn. Black leather lace up tap shoes.

Jazz: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn.

Girls: Nude split sole jazz shoes.

Boys: Black split sole jazz shoes.

Company: Ballet dress code with pink seamed tights for girls.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, footless or convertible tights. Dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing in Neutral or Academy colors*. Sneakers (not chunky) or dance sneakers.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

Level 3

Ballet:

Girls: Black leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, split sole ballet shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black, split sole ballet shoes.

Tap: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn. Black leather lace up tap shoes.

Jazz: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn.

Girls: Nude split sole jazz shoes.

Boys: Black split sole jazz shoes.

Company: Ballet dress code with pink seamed tights for girls.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, footless or convertible tights. Dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing that is Neutral or Academy colors*. Sneakers (not chunky) or dance sneakers.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

**For modern, lyrical, leaps and turns, and tap, students have the option to wear dance shorts or leggings in place of tights. Shorts must have an inseam of at least 4".*

Pre-Teen Students

Ballet:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, split sole ballet shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black, split sole ballet shoes.

Tap: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn. Black leather lace up tap shoes.

Jazz: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn.

Girls: Nude split sole jazz shoes.

Boys: Black split sole jazz shoes.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, footless or convertible tights. Dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing in Neutral or Academy colors*. Sneakers (not chunky), dance sneakers or jazz shoes.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

Teen Students

Ballet:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, pink footed tights. Pink, split sole ballet shoes.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts. Black, split sole ballet shoes.

Tap: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn. Black leather lace up tap shoes.

Jazz: Ballet dress code. Form fitting dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may be worn.

Girls: Nude split sole jazz shoes.

Boys: Black split sole jazz shoes.

Tumbling:

Girls: Any studio colored* leotard, footless or convertible tights. Dance shorts in Neutral or Academy colors* may also be worn.

Boys: White t-shirt, black athletic shorts.

Hip Hop: Form fitting clothing in Neutral or Academy colors*. Sneakers (not chunky) or dance sneakers.

Musical Theatre: Clothing that is easy to move in. No jeans.

Voice: No specific dress code.

Drama: Clothing that is easy to move in.

Hair (for All Levels)

Hair must be pulled back into a neat bun for all ballet classes. For all other dance subjects and musical theatre, hair must be pulled up and away from the face. For drama, voice and other non-dance classes, there is no hair dress code unless specified by the instructor.

Jewelry and Makeup

For dance and musical theatre classes: Light makeup may be worn. Jewelry may not be worn with the exception of small earrings.

For all other classes: No Dress Code (with regards to jewelry and makeup).



***Academy colors are pink, mulberry, eggplant and black (pictured from left to right).**

***Neutral colors are shades of white, tan and black.**

Studio leotards, warm up wear and shoes may be purchased at a discount through the studio during "ordering weeks." Ordering weeks will be scheduled for the first week of classes, the week prior to winter break and/or at the end of the dance year.
